JUNIOR HIGH PROGRAM

Language Arts (grades 7, 8 and 9) and Math (grades 7, 8 and 9) will be offered. These programs are for students who have not met the requirements for the next grade level or who want to improve their knowledge of the basic concepts in a particular subject. There is limited seating in these classes so register early.

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

High school courses will be offered to those students who want to: upgrade existing marks, complete pre-requisite courses and/or fast-track their high school program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students must have a pre-requisite mark of 65% to register in the next 10-20-30 academic-level course. A mark of no less than 40% is needed to move from an academic-level course to a more general course in the next stream.

RECOMMENDATIONS/EXPECTATIONS

Alberta Education curriculum requirements are the same for Summer School as they are in the regular school year. This compressed time frame can be extremely challenging. Expect a heavy workload with daily homework and assignments and less time to complete them.

A class period of 3.25 hours is equivalent to approximately 1 week of regular classes. There are also tutorials that you will be required to attend.

Summer School is a **choice** that students make when it meets their educational needs. We are, unfortunately, unable to accommodate all the individual needs of all students and families. Due to the nature of our compressed program the following rules apply:

- **DO NOT register for Summer School if you know you must miss some classes. Students will be withdrawn from classes after 3 absences.**
- If students miss due to illness, they must contact the teacher immediately to make arrangements to catch up **outside of class time.**
- Students who require **special provisions** will probably find one class enough work considering the compressed time frame involved. If you require provisions, **YOU MUST** make an appointment to see the Summer School Principal **before** registering. Not all provisions can be accommodated, and most are available for Diploma Exams only.

FEES

For each student registered in Summer School, a separate textbook deposit payment for \$80 **MUST** be included with registration and course payment. This deposit will be returned when all textbooks have been handed in. Make cheques payable to Medicine Hat School District.

- **Junior High: \$130 per course.**
- **High School: \$60 per course.**
- **Adults: \$600 per course.**
- **Out of District: \$600 per course.** (Refund for "funded credits" in January up to \$540)
- **International Students: \$1,200 per course.**
- **Medicine Hat Catholic School Division students: \$60 with approval of McCoy Principal.**
- Payment can be made in person at MHHS using cash or cheque.
- **No course refund will be issued after the first three (3) days of classes.**
- A copy of government issued ID must be provided with the signed registration form. I.e, Birth Certificate, Passport etc.
